Inspired by Tom Hull's statement in the documentary 'Between the Folds' that "Origami is a great way to get your hands dirty doing Math," this presentation will show just how dirty the folks in New Zealand and Australia are getting in their attempts to have mainstream schools consider the options paper folding can bring to their teaching.

Following up from Oates' paper at 4OSME on 'The Great Origami Maths & Science Show' the presenters share recent efforts to build on this material and develop new resources based on feedback from teachers and students. This includes recent work on static interactive exhibits utilizing step-folds, and the demonstration of a new concept recipe book of origami applications aimed at classroom teachers, origami instructors, lecturers and motivational speakers from a wide field of interests.
