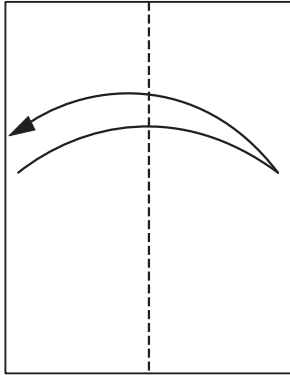


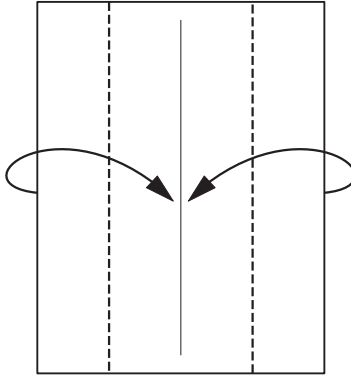

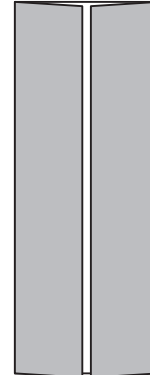
Although Known among folders as the "magazine cover box", This can made from almost any strong stiff paper of about the same propotion.



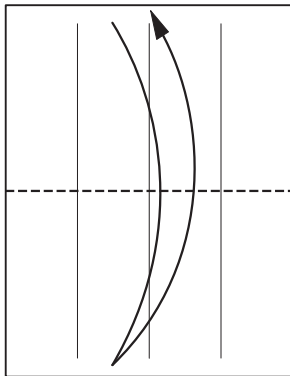
1. Fold in half lengthwise.
Unfold.



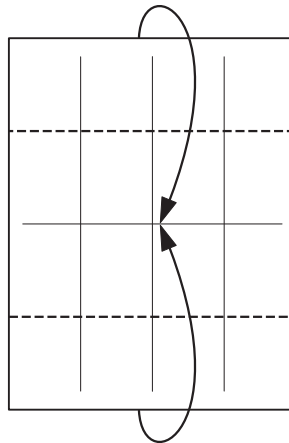
2. Bring longer edges to meet the center crease.



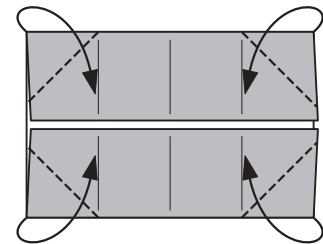
3. Unfold.



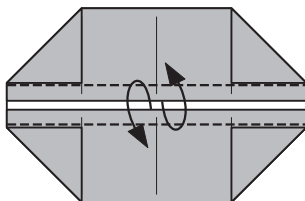
4. Book-fold crosswise.
Unfold.



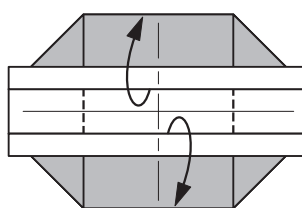
5. Bring the shorter edges to meet at the center crease.
This time leave the folds in.



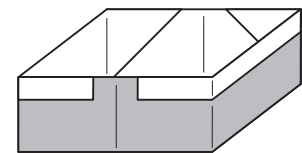
6. At each corner, bring the folded edge to lie along the nearest crease. Note that the cut edges do NOT reach the crosswise center line.



7. Fold the cut edges of the paper outward, one up and one down, as far as you can over the corner flaps to hold them in place.



8. Just made and pull them up and apart. The ends of the model will ffold upward to become the ends of a box. Pinch the corners of the box to make them square.



9. Finished Box! Make another for a lid. If you use a magazine cover, front and back, save the prettier one for the lid, and begin with the pretty side down. For very best result, the box should be a little smaller than the lid.
