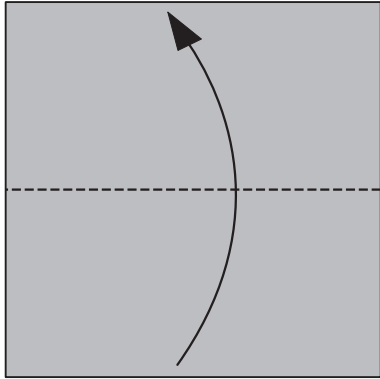
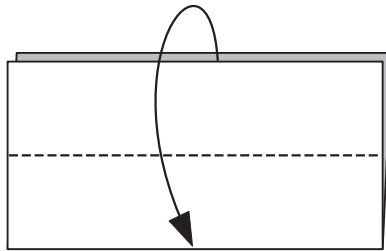


ROWBOAT and SNAPPING DRAGON HEAD

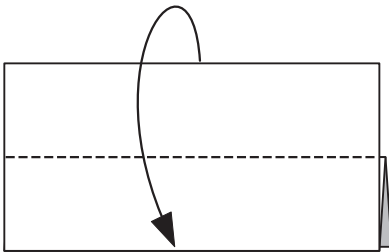
1. Paper square.
Fold in half like a book.



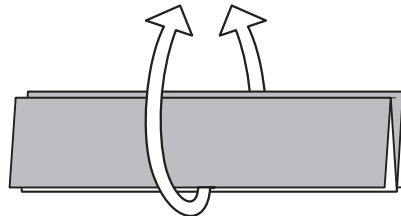
2. Fold one cut edge
down to folded edge.



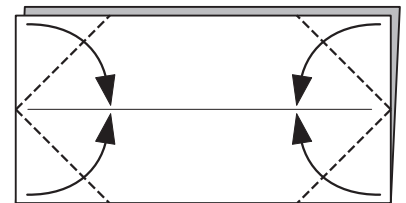
3. Turn over.



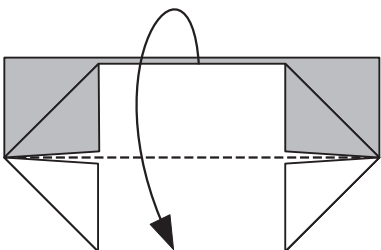
4. Fold one cut edge
down to folded edge.



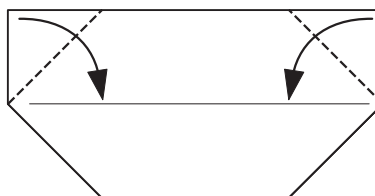
5. Unfold last two folds.



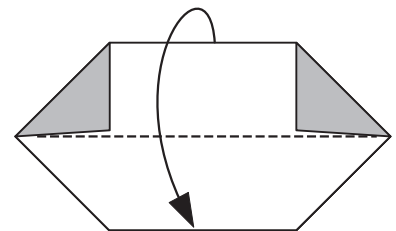
6. At top, fold upper layer only.
Turn in all four corners.



7. Fold Front layer of
top half down.
Turn over.

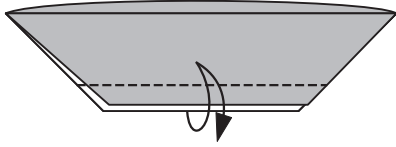


8. Turn in last pair of corners.

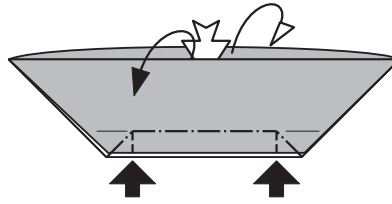


9. Fold top half down.

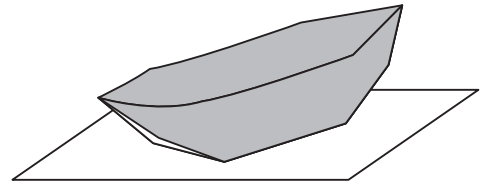
For Rowboat:



10a. Make a crease.

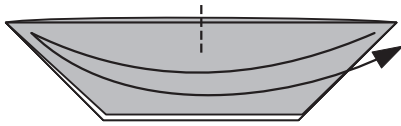


11a. Spread sides apart. Press inside of bottom down flat. Push in bottom corners with your thumb nail.

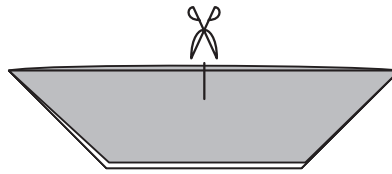


12a. Finished Boat. It will float. Put in something small but heavy, like a penny, to act as ballast.

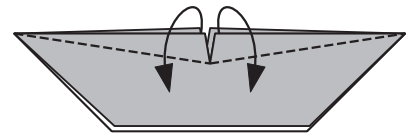
For Snapping Dragon Head:



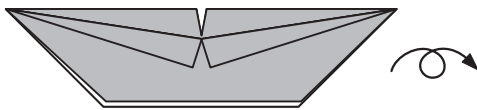
10b. Find middle of top edge by bringing ends together and pinching the fold at the edge only. Unfold.



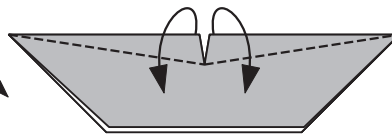
11b. At pinch mark, cut or tear all layers of paper about 1/4 of the way to the bottom edge.



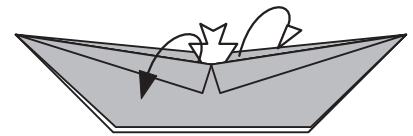
12b. Fold down edge of top layer only.



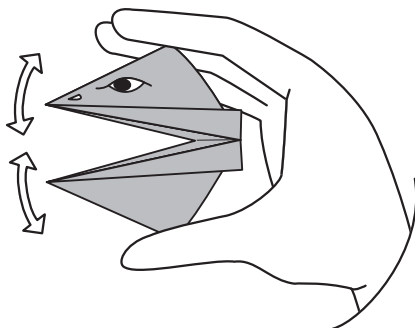
13b. Turn over.



14b. Fold down edge of this side too.



15b. Spread sides apart. Bring ends together.



17b. If you wish, draw a fierce face. As you open and close your hand, the Dragon snaps!
