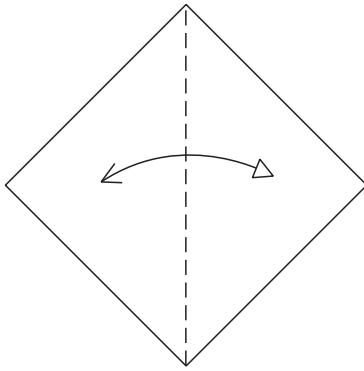
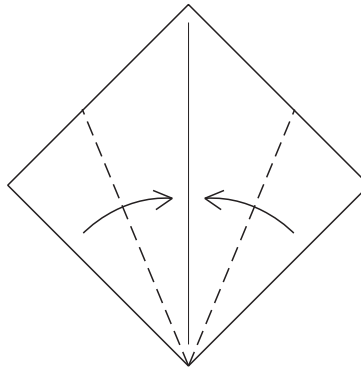


# Yapping Crow

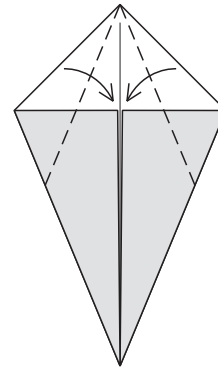

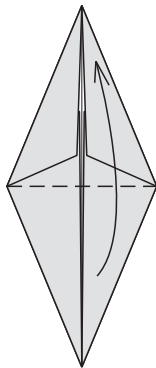
1. Begin with a square, white side up. Precrease along the diagonal with a mountain fold.



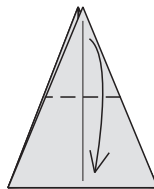
2. Valley fold the side edges towards the center crease.



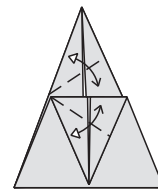
3. Valley fold the side edges towards the center.



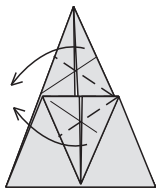
4. Valley fold the bottom point up to the top.



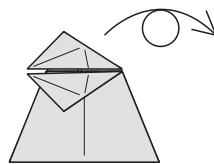
5. Valley fold the top flap down to the bottom edge.



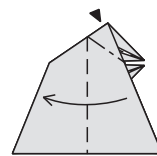
6. Precrease by folding the flaps to lie along the center, and then unfolding.



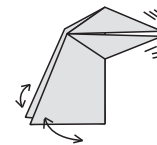
7. Valley fold the two flaps to lie along the center in the opposite direction.



8. Turn the model over.



9. Valley fold the model in half, allowing the two side points to get folded in half simultaneously.



10. Completed Yapping Crow. Swing the bottom points back and forth to make the model yap.
